- _____ **Health Form**, and all necessary medications.
These must be given to the camp nurse at check-in.
- _____ **Dean's Information sheet**. Give to dean at check-in.
- _____ Daytime casual clothes, a mixture of shirts, shorts, and jeans
- _____ Jacket / heavy sweater –adjust for weather
- _____ Sweatshirt / long sleeved shirt
- _____ 2 pair of comfortable (non-dress) shoes
flip flops may only be worn in cabin and at pool
- _____ Sleepwear, underwear, and socks
- _____ Swim suit (or 2) (Girls one piece; guys, no Speedo type trunks)
extra towels if attending sports or swim camp.
- _____ Raingear—plastic raincoat or poncho, adjust for event
- _____ Pillow and pillowcase; sleeping bag, extra blanket, **OR**
sheets, mattress cover (fitted single sheet makes good mattress
cover even with sleeping bag) and 2-3 blankets
–adjust for weather and event and camper needs
- _____ Towels & washcloths, (*minimum* of 2 sets for the week).
- _____ Toothpaste; toothbrush; brush/comb; shampoo;
deodorant; soap (**Warning: highly scented articles attract bees.**)
- _____ Flashlight (extra batteries and a bulb may help too)
- _____ *Cloth or mesh* dirty clothes bag (plastic bags invite mildew)
- _____ Stationery/postcards; envelopes; address list; *stamps*;
pen/pencil; notebook/paper.

- Electronic devices: CD player, walkman, ipod, computer game, tape recorder, radio, television, cell phone, pager, etc.
- Weapons: knife, switchblade, ax, hatchet, gun.
- Tobacco *in any form*, including snuff.
- Pets (*and don't take any home either!*)
- Alcohol
- Expensive clothing, jewelry, or watches
