In addition to study, recreation, camp quest (crafts and nature study), and worship times, everyone was expected to do a certain amount of work around camp such as weeding/mowing grass.

August 14, 1949, was the first Anniversary Day celebration. The attendance was 2500. After camping season was over, the Camping Committee determined that they needed more weeks for next year. There was a total of 909 campers in 1949.
